This survey will be conducted on _____ and will include an inspection of the vessel, vessel's structure, systems and equipment with inspection in water/out of water per Client's request. Further recommend that the vessel is hauled out for dry dock inspection of the wetted surface area of the hull and underwater machinery. A sea-trial may also be conducted per client's request if a driver is present at time of survey. Survey results will be transmitted only to the person or persons authorizing this survey. Survey report takes 3 business days following the survey. For your protection, NO information will be given to any parties, to include brokers, unless written permission is given Professional Marine Surveyors.

The purpose of this survey will be to determine the condition and approximate market value of the above vessel. Professional Marine Surveyors will rely upon information provided by the owner, and or broker when conducting said survey. Professional Marine Surveyors will not be responsible for checking the truth and veracity of the provided information, and shall be held harmless for its reliance on the same.

The report will be prepared after a thorough visual examination of the hull, machinery, rigging, hardware and equipment. Neither joiner work or fasteners will be removed nor will any destructive testing be performed without written consent by the owner to Professional Marine Surveyors. Only accessible areas will be inspected, and it is understood that the surveyor assumes no responsibility for any defects not found in non-accessible areas. Furthermore, Professional Marine Surveyors is not responsible for conditions or defects which may arise following the conducted survey. The report should not be considered to be an express or implied warranty, or guarantee regarding the condition of the vessel or its equipment.

By signing this Work Order for Marine Survey, the client, client's agent or person requesting this survey agree that Professional Marine Surveyors, its employees and contractors enter upon the surveyed vessel as an invitee of the vessel's owner.

Client, client's agent or persons requesting this survey agrees to the charges as set forth above and to the provisions as set forth in this document. Survey results are intended to represent the physical condition of the vessel only on the day of survey. Additionally, the survey will not address the vessel's stability, characteristics, inherent defects or the internal condition of the machinery. Professional Marine Surveyor's Urges that all gasoline and diesel engines be surveyed by a qualified Engine Surveyor to determine the condition of the engines, gears and pumps, heat exchangers, coolers, etc. Operation of AC and DC electrical systems will be conducted only to verify the basic operation of those systems as specifically listed in the report. Comments concerning cosmetics are made at the discretion of the surveyor and should be considered the surveyor's opinion.

In the event that it becomes necessary to bring legal action to enforce the payment provisions of this agreement, the client shall be responsible for paying the reasonable collection costs of such action including attorney fees and other related costs. Should the client, for any reason, seek to bring legal action against the Surveyor or Professional Marine Surveyors the total of any damages that may be awarded will be limited to the charge for the survey as listed above. This Agreement shall be construed, interpreted and the rights of the parties hereto determined in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma without regard to choice of law principals thereof. Proper Venue for any legal action shall be in Carter County Oklahoma.

The client shall have the right to cancel this agreement up to three calendar days prior to the date of the survey. Cancellation after this date will require the client to pay Professional Marine Surveyors the minimum daily surveyor fee of \$400.00.

Payment information: All payments must be received prior to the survey date scheduled. Checks are accepted. Credit Cards are accepted but a 3% processing fee is required on each transaction.
